

Socomec at Build and Connect symposium

Benfeld, 24 November 2016

Socomec is a partner of the Build and Connect symposium that was held on 22 and 23 November 2016 in Strasbourg. Pioneering technologies and practices in the sustainable building sector were the keynote issues on the agenda.

The first international Build and Connect symposium was held on 22-23 November in Strasbourg.

The event, organised in cooperation with the “Fibres Énergivie” hub (whose board of directors includes Socomec CEO Ivan Steyert) and energy building hubs from the Upper Rhine region, was the ideal platform to share experiences and good practices in the construction, renovation and sustainable operation of buildings.

The venue brought together nearly 500 professionals from the building and real estate sectors, including main contractors, local authorities, architects, engineering consultancies and energy companies from France, Germany and Switzerland.

Via roundtable discussions and workshops, over 70 speakers shared their experiences and innovations in the fields of pioneering technologies and practices in sustainable buildings.

Socomec presented its feedback and energy storage solutions that have been implemented in various pilot projects.

This includes, for example, the Nice Grid smart district project in the town of Carros, near Nice in the south of France, and the Solenbat positive energy building, the result of collaboration between leading Alsatian manufacturing companies (Voltec, Hager, Socomec) who have been approved by the Alsace Fibres Energivie competitiveness hub dedicated to positive energy buildings (PEBs).

The Solenbat PEB is located in Benfeld and houses Socomec’s new industrial and logistics centre.
